**ADDENDUM 2: CLARIFICATION**

In response to bidder request for clarification, GDC wishes to respond as follows;

**Bidders Question 1**

Request the delivery period be extended from the sixty days (60) days specified in the tender document?

**GDC Response**

GDC wishes to amend section IV - special condition of contract clause 3.10.1, to read as follows; The delivery period for items shall be **six (6) months or less** after contract signing. It is GDC's desire to have the items delivered within the shortest time possible. Any tenderer with a delivery period exceeding six (6) months will be disqualified. Partial delivery shall not be accepted.

**Bidders Question 2**

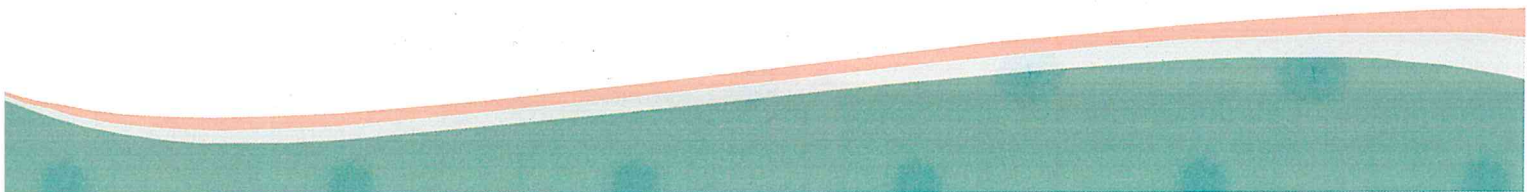
On the payment schedule, kindly consider accepting 30 days payment from bill of lading date with confirmed letter of credit in place?

**GDC Response**

The payment terms are as specified in the tender document section IV - special condition of contract clause 3.12.1.

**GDC Response**

The delivery point and commercial term is as stated in the tender document – Delivery Duty Paid to Menengai, Nakuru County.

**Bidders Question 4**


Will valves with EPI Geoshield which has a hardness of Rc 78 compared to that of Rc 43 for stellite?

**GDC Response**

GDC Minimum requirement for valves with EPI Geoshield hardness is Rc 43 for stellite.
