ADDENDUM 1: CLARIFICATION



In response to bidder's request for clarification, GDC wishes to provide the following response;

S.N	BIDDER'S REQUEST	GDC'S RESPONSE
1.	Tender Security: a) As part of mandatory evaluation requirements, the bidder is to "provide an Original tender security in the amount of Kshs. 500,000.00 in the form of a bank or insurance guarantee issued by a bank or insurance operating in Kenya and valid for at least thirty (30) days beyond the tender validity period". This Contradicts with ITT 21.1: "A Tender Security shall be required; the amount and currency of the Tender Security shall be 2% of the total tender sum in the form of bank or insurance guarantee issued by a bank or insurance operating in Kenya. The security shall be valid for 150 days from the date of tender closing/opening"- Which clause between the above two requirements should suffice in this tender?	The Tender Security shall be Kshs. 500,000.00 in the form of a bank or insurance guarantee issued by a bank or insurance operating in Kenya and valid for at least thirty (30) days beyond the tender validity period.
2.	On page 53 of tender document under schedule of quantities we are requesting for a confirmation for length of various items like pipes and any other item that has a length variation	The average drill pipe length is 10.5 m
3	We request to get clarification on frequency of inspection within the 18 months contract period.	The Inspection process is continuous through the 18 months.
