1.0 NTRODUCTION

Geothermal Development Company (GDC) is 100% state-owned corporation registered under the Companies Act (CAP 486); it was incorporated in 2008 as a special purpose vehicle to accelerate the development of geothermal energy in Kenya. GDC falls under the Ministry of Energy & Petroleum. The Company has offices in Nairobi, Naivasha Nakuru and Baringo towns with most of

Currently GDC is using SAP R/3 ERP 6.0 Enhancement Packages including the following modules; Financial Accounting (FI), Controlling (CO), Material Management (MM), Human Capital Management (HCM) including Medicare, Project Management (PS), Plant Maintenance (PM), Audit Information System (AIS) and Technical Modules: SAP Basis & SAP ABAP.

2.0 SCOPE OF THE ASSIGNMENT

The objective of the SAP ERP audit/assurance review is to provide management with an independent assessment relating to the effectiveness of controls and security of the organisation's SAP ERP architecture.

1) The review will focus on effectiveness of controls installed during system implementation of the relevant SAP ERP

- components and modules within the enterprise.
- 2) Review all the security features to determine their effectiveness and advise on improvements if any.
- ₃) Perform controls maturity analysis: Assess how GDC's systems Practices within SAP compare to international best practices.
- To assess the current level of knowledge and skills of the trainees in the audit department and identify both the knowledge gaps and the expected skills trainees lack so that the training content will be built based on those specific needs (gap 4) analysis).
- Facilitate training for the audit staff in application controls audit 5)
- Conduct on the job training for 14 auditors in application controls and the use of CAATs in gathering audit evidence. 6)

3.0 OBJECTIVES OF THE AUDIT

- The Systems audit is planned to answer the following key issues:
 a) Are there adequate general System controls and application controls to mitigate the System risks facing the organization? Identify control deficiencies and propose ways of addressing these deficiencies
 Assess system development/configuration management controls to provide reasonable assurance that the system operates b)
